Suzanne, a self-proclaimed "Bridgeport Art Lifer," is a pioneer and leader in the Bridgeport arts community. She created the Bridgeport Art Trail, a four-day celebration of all things creative, cultural and arts-related in Bridgeport. As a 2017 Arts Hero, Suzanne was honored as part of Connecticut Arts Day at the State Capitol in Hartford. Since 2008 Suzanne has produced large and small community-based cultural events and partnered with or advised other groups and individuals regarding cultural planning or programs for the Greater Bridgeport Community. She was actively involved in the first City Lights Coffee House & Gallery, located on Fairfield Avenue in the 80's.

#### Eligibility

- ◇ Open to all artists 18 years of age or over.
- ◇ Two entries per artist (abstract and/or representational art accepted): oils, acrylics, watercolors, pastels, drawings, mixed media only. Gallery wrap will be accepted at the discretion of EAC.
- ◇ Sculpture will be accepted; sculptors must provide their own pedestals. No giclée, canvas transfers, photography or computer images.
- ◇ Substitutions and/or late entries will not be accepted.

#### Awards

- First Prize \$100
- Second Prize \$75
- Honorable Mention \$50
- Awards will be made at the discretion of the judge

#### Restrictions

- ◇ Must be framed and wired for hanging (no saw-tooth hanger)
- ◇ Complete label (see next page) tape to front/back of artwork
- ◇ Artist must hand-deliver & pickup work at Easton Library
- ◇ Artwork must be for sale & available till end of show
- ◇ Art must be available for sale from delivery till end of show
- ◇ Artwork must not have been in any previous EAC Shows
- ◇ Size limitation, no larger than 40"x40"
- ◇ Artwork must not have been in any previous EAC show.
