ALEX MCFARLANE, JUROR

Alex McFarlane is a graduate of Columbia University’s School of the Arts and an early pioneer of the Tribeca arts community in lower Manhattan. His work has been exhibited extensively throughout New York and beyond, earning him a respected place within both private and public collections. Notably, three of his sculptures are held by the William Benton Connecticut State Museum of Art at the University of Connecticut, Storrs.

McFarlane’s contributions to the visual arts have been recognized with numerous honors, including awards from the Tiffany Foundation and the New York Foundation for the Arts. He is also a Fellow of the prestigious Augustus Saint-Gaudens Foundation. His work has been reviewed by Grace Glueck in *The New York Times* and featured by Holland Cotter in *Arts Magazine*, underscoring the critical attention his practice has received.

In addition to his visual art career, McFarlane is an accomplished playwright. His play *Birds Should Fly Free* was produced at the New York International Fringe Festival and was the subject of a feature article by Laura Collins-Hughes in the theater section of *The New York Times*. He currently teaches as an instructor at the Silvermine School of Art in New Canaan, Connecticut, where he continues to mentor emerging artists.

- Sculpture will be accepted; no giclée, canvas transfers, photography or computer images.

- Second Prize \$75
- Honorable Mention \$50
- Awards will be made at the discretion of the judge.

RESTRICTIONS

- ◆ Must be framed or finished edges and wired for hanging.
- ◆ Complete label, tape to front/back of artwork.
- ◆ Artist must hand-deliver & pickup work at Easton Library.
- ◆ Art must be available for sale from delivery till end of show.
- ◆ Artwork must not have been in any previous EAC Shows.
- ◆ Size limitation, no larger than 40" x 40".
